ICC 2019 Proposal of Scientific Committee and Local Organizing Committee

AIC – Italian Cartographic Association – proposes a bid to organize the 29th International Cartographic Conference in 2019 (ICC2019) in Florence, Italy.

We would like to propose the following titles:


- The new cartography, between recovery of tradition and prospects of development and interaction
- Cartography: planning our future from lessons from the past

These titles recall the main idea behind the organization of the Conference, that is to make the point about today's situation of cartography in the world, considering future development perspectives made possible thanks to the new technical and scientific opportunities that produced the virtualization of the traditional paper formats.

In such sense we must remind the past Italian tradition in map making, both from the institutional cartographic bodies and mapping agencies, and from private companies, such as Touring Club Italiano and De Agostini, just to mention few names that in the past represented a high standard in the map making sector, as well as the most recent evolution allowed by the Geographic Information instruments applied to cartography, as GIS, Remote Sensing, GNSS, etc.

This tradition will be also maintained, as the local producers, companies, experts and scholars will be active in organizing the Map Exhibition and Trade Show.

AIC – Italian Cartographic Association has recently celebrated its 50th year since its foundation that took place in 1964. Since the beginning of its history, the Association gathers scholars, professionals, mapping agencies, map makers and simple amateur cartographers in its activities, which include a yearly Conference, a collection of works done by associates into a four-monthly Bulletin, as well as several local activities, these including prizes for young cartographers and for school children. In more recent times the Association evolved and has been more and more active on the national and international contexts involving Geographic Information and Cartography. At national level the Association is part of ASITA, the



A few years ago a double blind revision process has been introduced, while now the papers submitted are generally either in English or in Italian with English Title, abstract and keyords, and from year 2015 a full double language (Italian and English) realization of the common parts of the Bulletin will be provided. In occasion of ICC 2019 we could therefore consider the realization of a thematic 'ICA issue' in which some of the top keynotes papers and summaries of the conference days could be located.

The Association and its associates are also active, from the academic point of view, in domains as geography, geodesy, geology, cartography, etc. and this is de facto providing links and proficient connections with other scientific associations and communities. In the occasion of a Florence based ICC 2019, such network of connections could be converted into a renovated interest in cartography and therefore participation of new scholars to the ICA World and Conference.

In proposing the organization of ICC 2019 we therefore aim at maintaining the traditional structure of ICA events of themes and topics tackled in the commissions' works, adopting the typical structure of the presence of plenary and thematic sessions, in order to highlight some topics that we consider the cutting edge of the cartographic debate. We therefore propose the following thematic issues, to be covered either in terms of specific sessions or as ideal 'backbone' of the conference's spirit.

Cartography in and over the Web 2.0

the Italian Cartographic Association.

The current role of cartography will be considered, particularly after the diffusion of instruments such as the ICT technologies, Internet in particular and the Web 2.0, with the opportunity of transforming users in 'neogeographers' or 'new cartographers, considering also quality and reliability of such kind of information.

- Cartography as decision support tools and to foster sustainability

The topic will represent an occasion to reflect on maps as tools to understand world problems, to take decisions for a sustainable governance and to adopt active policies for protecting environmental and cultural goods as well as to protect landscape and biodiversity.

The quality of spatial data

Problems of geographical and statistical data analysis will be tackled, also with reference to the issues related to quality, both in terms of precision, reliability and detail, as well as in terms of location precision. Open (cartographic) data will be also analysed and considered.

Cartography and Geographic Information Systems

A wide attention will be dedicated to Geographic Information Systems, both commercial and open source ones, with reference to their contribution to map making and to keeping up-to-date



cartographic products, processes and Geographic information. Also, their role in spatial planning and management as well as in applied scientific research and in studying and teaching will be analysed.

Cartography and Remote Sensing

The topic will tackle the role of Remote Sensing in producing georeferenced, frequent, continuous and very high definition data, as well as the innovation in aerial – including UAV - and satellite vectors, and the evolution of sensors, these including multi-spectral and multi temporal ones.

- Unconventional Cartography: networks, news, media, art and participation

The topic will tackle the role of cartography in the globalized world evaluating the presence of weight of social networks and media, trying to understand their diffusion and comprehension and the trends of participatory cartography, the experiences in producing participated maps and charts and the opportunities, limits and risks related to such phenomenon. In a similar way, the artistic use of maps and cartographic representation will be faced, also for multimedia, multidimensional data and the creation of interfaces for public and private realizations.

- Historical Cartography and History of Cartography
- Classical aspects and reflections on historical charts and maps will be tackled from those of the more and less recent past, in which they played an important role in research and analysing the historical evolution of space and landscape, reflecting on its path in terms of its functions, innovations, productions and geographical discovery. A full history of cartography, covering all the aspects that participants will be interested in tackling and presenting.
- Cartography and culture. Promotion and diffusion. Last but not least, the importance of maps in culture will be analysed and observed, with reference to the needs of disseminating culture and knowledge, to reinforce World's democracies and to foster liveability, prosperity and human values.

SCIENTIFIC COMMITTEE AND LOCAL ORGANIZING COMMITTEE (LOC)

The scientific organization of the Congress will be led by a Scientific Committee of eminent scholars and technicians in the fields of culture, research and applied science to cartography and related disciplines, such as geomatics, GIS, Remote Sensing, Informatics, Toponomastics, topography, geography and history of cartography. The Committee's members will be chosen for the role they play in their fields at National and International levels, trying to cover all the scientific aspects that in some ways interact with maps and charts as 'final products' of a cross-discipline cartographic path.

This group could be also integrated by the representatives of the official Italian mapping agencies, whose directors are *de jure* members of the executive council of AIC – Italian Cartographic Association: Italian Geographical Military Institute (IGMI), Italian Navy Hydrographic Institute, CIGA - Cartographic Center of the Italian Air Force, the Geological Survey (now ISPRA), the Cadastre, now part of the Italian Revenue Agency.

The Local Organizing Committee will consist of members chosen within the Scientific Committee of the Association and between academics and professionals active in the fields of cartography, geodesy, geographic information, and also, from a more operational point of view, by Firenze Convention Bureau



and Firenze Fiera Congress & Exhibition Center, (the managing Company of the venue which will host the conference), together with a Professional Conference Organizer (PCO) appointed by the Firenze Convention Bureau, that will be responsible for the organizing secretariat and the budget of the Congress. The PCO who has been appointed to handle all the organizational aspects of the conference is AIM Group (www.aimgroup.eu), a leading company in events and congresses management, with an experience of more than 50 years and 12 offices operating in the whole world.

The Scientific Committee will also act in order to involve ICA members within its structure, inviting to take place to meetings and important events in which a more direct involvement of ICA will be required.

Also, the Scientific Committee together with the LOC and ICA will, at a second stage, identify a Map Exhibition Committee that will be in charge of organizing the more technical aspects of the Map Exhibition that usually accompanies ICC events.

As you might remember, this is the second time that AIC and the city of Florence are bidding to host the ICC so we are really hoping that this time we will be able to show you that Florence could be the perfect place for this prestigious conference.

GUIDED TOUR OF FLORENTINE HILLS-FIESOLE AND PIAZZALE MICHELANGELO

Visit to the Duomo or Church of San Romolo, very ancient church with an unusual bell tower. Visit to the Roman theatre, which was built during the first Imperial period and later, enlarged by Septimius Severus.

Drive to Piazzale Michelangelo, from where there is a wonderful view of Florence in all its beauty with the Duomo, Santa Croce, the towers and bell towers peaking out from the reddish roofs, the gardens and the Arno river that winds its way across the city. Here one can admire the Basilica of San Miniato al Monte. This church is one of the most famous examples of the Florentine Romanesque style.



GUIDED TOUR OF SIENA & SAN GIMIGNANO

Excursion by bus to Siena and S. Gimignano: Drive through the Chianti region to the medieval town of Siena (tour of the Cathedral, Town Hall, Piazza del Campo).

Lunch in a typical restaurant, on the way back visit to S. Gimignano, a charming little town with narrow streets paved with red bricks which has remained almost intact since the Middle Ages.



THE CHIANTI AREA

This is internationally renowned as one of the finest wine producing areas of the world recognized as such since the 16th century.

We will travel through the sloping hills covered by vineyards and stop for wine-tasting and lunch in a typical example of Tuscan wine producing farm, The Castello di Vicchiomaggio, built between the 9th and 15th century.

On the way we will visit the Monastero della Certosa (the Florence Chapter house) built in 1341 and then donated to the Carthusian monks, and the church of San Leolino.



Outside the walls of Florence





From the 15th to the early 18th century, the Medici family played a decisive political role in the Tuscan territory, adding to their city homes, more specifically connected with the exercise of their power, these places for recreation and hunting which, thanks to the Medici patronage, became meeting places for literati, philosophers, and artists. The group of villas was built during the phase of the family's political success, while the city of Florence was becoming the heart of the formation, and later the expansion throughout Europe, of the Renaissance culture.

The villas were splendid residences, rich with works of art (Botticelli's "Spring" was painted for the villa in Castello). **In 2013, the Medici villas were added to UNESCO's World Heritage list.**
